

PARK RULES

- Check-In Time is 12:00 PM.
- **One camping unit (trailer, fifth wheel, motorhome, etc.) per reserved campsite.**
- **One second car per reserved campsite.**
- **No more than 8 people per reserved campsite.**
- Vehicles must be parked at a reserved campsite, designated parking area, or primitive camping area.
- All portable fire pits must have a bottom. No open bottom fire rings allowed.
- No rock pit fires. Containers are provided on the primitive side of the campground, with built in containers.
- Fire pits are provided in reserved campsites.
- **Camp fires must be out by 11:00 PM.**
- Do Not Burn trash in burn barrels. Please use trash receptacles.
- No Fireworks.
- All vehicles must be licensed, registered, and insured. No off road vehicles.
- Dogs must be leashed at all times (no longer than 10 feet, and in the hands of a responsible individual).
- Please pick up after your pets.
- Do not damage any vegetation, buildings, or Parks Department property.
- No camping in Day Use Only areas.
- No Hunting.
- Check-Out Time is 12:00 PM.

QUIET HOURS

10:00 PM to 7:00 AM

Amplified sound & generators must be turned off at this time.
Please keep general noise at a level that is respectful of other campers.
