WELCOME TO OUR KID'S CLUB PROGRAM

Available afterschool - 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday with the exception of holidays and teacher workdays.

Kid's Club is offered on Minimum days for no additional fee. Kids Club starts and ends at Zephyr Cove Elementary School.



Kids Club payments are a flat monthly fee based on the number of school days per month. Schedules are available at the front counter of Kahle Community Center.

Kid's Club Payment

1. Kid's Club Payment is a flat monthly fee based on the number of school days per month.
The program fee is \$6.00 per day. Each month will vary in cost.

Late Pick-ups

- A late charge will be assessed if you are late picking up your child.
- If you are late (6:01 – 6:16 PM) to pick up your child, you will be charged \$5.00.
- An additional \$1.00 will be charged for every minute thereafter.
- If you are late more than twice in one week, your child will not be allowed to attend the following week.
- If you have 5 or more late pick-ups during the school year, your child may be dropped from the program entirely.

Personal Belongings

To help keep track of your child's items, we ask that you label you child's belongings. Kid's Club staff is not responsible for your child's belongings.

Parent Involvement

Parents are welcome at Kid's Club to observe or to help out during the program. It is helpful that as a parent, you keep the kid's club leaders informed of any changes of schedule or anything else that might be helpful to them in caring for your child.

Messages & Announcements

Any changes in the Kid's Club schedule will be given to the parent in the way of a note or flyer.

Kid's Club Discipline Policy

It is the goal of the Douglas County Parks & Recreation Department's programs to provide a supportive environment in which children can grow and develop. Positive child guidance management methods are used in our programs.

The Kid's Club contract is between the participant and the club. If a child abuses the rules or requires constant attention from the staff, the child will be given a verbal warning.

If the child continues to violate the rules, a time out will be given.

The parent's signature on the Disciplinary Action Form is to inform them of the situation and the consequences of any further incidents.

1st Disciplinary Action Form: Write up and inform parent of behavior

2nd Disciplinary Action Form: Write up and inform parent of behavior

3rd Disciplinary Action Form: Suspension from the program up to 1 week at the discretion of the Recreation Department

An additional Disciplinary Action Forms will result in suspension or expulsion from the program at the discretion of the Recreation Department.

NOTE: Disciplinary Action Forms carry over to Camps and other recreation sponsored activities for one
