

Irrigation Audits for Large Water Users



For most water users the majority of their bill is spent on outside irrigation during the summer months. In an effort to assist large water users, such as homeowners associations, with methods of reducing outdoor water consumption, Carson Water Subconservancy District (CWSD) is offering irrigation system water audits within the Carson River Watershed. This audit includes an irrigation system audit performed by a certified water audit professional. CWSD is offering this irrigation survey at no cost; however, participation includes providing CWSD with usage and cost data before and after the audit.

The irrigation audits will be performed by a certified water audit contractor working in conjunction with representatives of CWSD and will include the following:

1. Presentations to HOA Board or Business Representative as requested.
2. Pre-Audit Evaluation: Site Inspection, water usage evaluation, and system tune-up procedure conducted by CWSD staff.
3. Irrigation Audit by Certified Professional.
4. A water conservation report outlining proposed implementation measures to reduce usage and costs will be provided after the audit.

This program is designed to help large water users reduce outdoor water consumption in their respective communities, especially during peak demand times. The effective use of our limited water resources is vital to maintaining our thriving communities and healthy watershed.
