## What to Bring

Campers are encouraged to bring a lunch, water bottle, sunscreen, and hat in a single backpack or bag that can be closed completely with a zipper, snap, or latch each day. Additionally, please wear closed-toed shoes for safety.

All items from home, including backpacks, should be clearly labeled with the camper's first and last name, please. We ask that all personal items, such as electronic devices, toys, etc. remain at home.

Snacks will be provided for each child each afternoon. In case of allergy or nutritional concerns, you can also bring snacks from home.

## Registration

To register, a current DCPR Youth Activity Registration Packet *must* be on file prior to enrollment. These are available at the community center and online.

Registration opens on Tuesday, January 2nd and is on a first-come, first-served basis. Registration will be available in-person, over the phone, as well as online for the first time. In-person or online is preferable over calling as phones can run the risk of getting overloaded with call volume.
